Dear Sir,

With reference to your offer at SI 3 above and endorsement of the same by MPCB at SI 4 above, we are pleased to award the subject work in your favour for a value of Rs. **1466132.95** (Rupees Fourteen Lakhs Sixtysix Thousand one hundred thirty two and paise ninety five only) with following stipulations :-

- (1) The Agreement in the enclosed format (Annexure-1) on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- shall be entered between M/s VIDHARBHA ENVIRO PROTECTION LIMITED, Nagpur and Area General Manager (AGM) of the respective Area as per the terms and conditions contained therein along with the rates endorsed by MPCB (appended below) and quantities to be disposed Area-wise (Annexure-2).

- (2) The VEPL shall contact the Area Nodal Officer (Env.) of the concerned Areas for execution of agreement and finalization of programme of work including finalization of distance between each HEMM Work Shop/Store and CHWTSDF at Butibori.
- (3) Before commencement of the work, the distance between the HEMM Work Shop/Store and CHWTSDF at Butibori shall be physically verified jointly by VEPL, Area Nodal Officer (Env.) and the Nodal Officer (Env.) of respective project and the same shall be recorded and jointly signed as basic record for transportation charges.
- (4) Your Consent is valid up to 28.02.2015. Before continuing your work beyond 28.02.2015, you will submit Consent from MPCB for the balance period of the contract.
- (5) The date of Commencement of Work shall be reckoned from 10th day of issue of this Work Order.
- (6) The payments shall be made in respect of providing the services by VEPL as per rates duly endorsed by MPCB as under :

Disposal charges for Incineration	Rs. 18800.00 per MT
Transportation Charges	Rs. 4.17 per MT per KM
Unloading Charges	Rs. 100.00 per MT
MIDC Charges (on disposal, unloading & transportation charges)	5% on billed Amount
Service Tax	12.36%

- (7) Loading of Hazardous Waste (Used oil filters, hose pipes & cotton waste) into the trucks arranged by M/s VEPL, shall be the responsibility of Concerned Area/Sub Area/Unit. The actual quantities loaded by WCL shall be suitably recorded jointly by VEPL and the Engineer in charge /Project Nodal Officer (Env) and duly accepted by the Area Nodal Officer (Env.).
- (8) The payment shall be made at Area level by the respective Area of WCL and the paying authority shall be Area General Manager.
- (9) You are required to obtain license as per the provisions of Contract Labour (Regulations & Abolition) Act 1970, and submit the same to the respective Area General Manager, failing which, no bill will be paid against the work done.
- (10) The Work shall be executed and maintained as per the provisions of agreement and instructions of Engineer in Charge/Nodal Officer (Env.) of the Project.
- (11) The Area Nodal Officer (Environment) of the concerned Area shall be responsible for overall co-ordination and implementation as per schedule and will be assisted by the Nodal Officer (Environment) of the respective Project/Unit.



Subject : Approval for Award of work of Disposal of Hazardous Waste (used oil filters , hose pipes & cotton waste) generated at the mines / units of WCL for a period of one year , to M/S Vidarbha Enviro Protection Limited (VEPL) , Nagpur on single offer basis without tender , the Common Hazardous Waste , Treatment , Storage & Disposal facility (CHWTSDF) at Butibori duly authorised by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB) for Nagpur , Chandrapur & Yavatmal Districts .

Noting upto pre-pages may please be referred . Proposal in question has been examined . After examination , it has been observed that

1. subject proposal is for approval for award of work for Disposal of Hazardous Waste (used oil filters , hose pipes & cotton waste) generated at the mines / units of WCL for a period of one year through M/S VEPL , Nagpur on single offer basis without tender .
2. It is indicated that M/S VEPL , Nagpur is authorised by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB) for Nagpur , Chandrapur & Yavatmal District as sole operator of CHWTSDF .
3. It is recorded that eslier subject work was awarded to M/S VEPL , Nagpur on single offer basis after obtaining competent approval vide Work Order dated 24.05.2012 for a quantity of 69.60Te amounting to Rs.1257356.33 for a period of one year & same was informed to WCL Board to comply the CVC guidelines . The said work order has expired .
4. Subject proposal consists disposal of 61.94Te hazardous waste which includes existing stock as 27.45Te and 34.49Te expected quantity to be generated in coming one year .
5. Proposed recommended amount is Rs.1466132.95 whichh is based on revised rates for collection , transportation & disposal of hazardous wastes w.e.f 1st Dec'2013 submitted by M/S VEPL , Nagpur vide letter dated 26.11.2013 .
6. It is indicated that letter dated 26.11.2013 of M/S VEPL was forwarded to Regional Officer , MPCB , Nagpur for their perusal and the Sub-Officer , MPCB , Nagpur-1 vide letter dated 2.05.2014 have endorsed the revised rates of M/S VEPL w.e.f 01.12.2013 and directed WCL to treat and dispose hazardous waste through M/S VEPL , Butibori , Nagpur .
7. Proposal is examined by GM(Envt) and they have recommended for award the subject work to M/S VEPL , Nagpur on single offer basis without tender for a total amount of Rs.1466132.95 for a period of 1 year and indicated that same will be posted on WCL Website in public domain and shall be brought to the notice of WCL Board for information in terms of CVC guidelines dated 11.12.2012 & 19.05.2010 respectively .
8. It has been observed that Consent To Operate of CHWTSDF by M/S VEPL , Nagpur granted by MPCB is valid for a period upto 28.02.2015 and GM(Envt) vide letter dated 22.07.2014 has requested M/S VEPL , Nagpur to get the Consent to Operate extended beyond 28.02.2015 .

In view of the above , proposal as recommended by GM(Envt) for award the subject work to M/S VEPL , Nagpur on single offer basis without tender may be considered for approval of competent authority subject to budget certification . Since recommended amount is Rs.1466132.95 which is based on existing stock and expected quantity generated & disposed off in coming 1 year , proposal may be considered for administrative approval of Director(T)PP . However , it is to be ensured that award of subject proposal is posted in website and brought to the notice of WCL Board to comply the CVC guidelines and MPCB has extended Consent To Operate of CHWTSDF by M/S VEPL , Nagpur for the contract period beyond 28.02.2015 .
